

## **WP4 Tools**

**WP4** will produce five practical and knowledge-based QI/QA tools for HIV health promotion and prevention in Europe, including guidance and training materials. We will build on the existing, evidence-based tools adapted by the network IQhiv:

- Succeed
- QIP
- PQD

And develop two new tools:

- A QA tool within the area of health promotion and prevention targeting people who inject drugs (PWID)
- A tool designed specifically for programs: Programs are ongoing operations consisting of many elements /projects. For now we call this "The Program Tool"

Initial versions will be used in **WP5** for training, **WP6** for implementation and evaluated by **WP3**. Feedback from demonstration pilots will be incorporated in the final versions produced by **WP4**. **WP2** will disseminate the tools to all HIV prevention stakeholders.

**WP4** will also produce a tool selection guide and guidelines for the translation of tools and training materials.

As we have to deliver the first versions of the tools and training materials by February 2014 we have already started our work. We are looking forward to continue this work with you all!
