- Partnership between SHC and HSE in Ireland
- Use an international team of trainers to prepare and support local experts to provide QA/QI technical assistance at national and sub-national levels.
- Collaborate with WP4 on Tools
- Collaborate with WP6 on in-country capacity building and technical assistance
- ELearning tool – we will need the collaboration of everyone else on this
- Participating member states will organise training workshops for a wider HIV prevention audience on a national or sub-regional level, depending on the size of their HIV prevention workforce.
