



# **WP6 Practical Application**

#### What does WP 6 want to accomplish?

• WP 6 wants to accomplish the application of at least 80 quality improvement/ quality assurance (QI/ QA) tools in HIV Prevention projects/ programs throughout Europe. All WP 6 activities aim to enable and assist these applications.

## What actions will take place in WP 6 to achieve this?

- We will develop *criteria* to assist you (and other interested stakeholders) in choosing
  - a. a matching QI/ QA tool
  - b. to a suitable/ relevant project/ program
  - c. in a beneficial/ supportive environment
  - d. to support your (or that stakeholder's) work.
- We will assist you (and any other interested stakeholder) with the *planning of the* tool application phase (at the end of the first tool training block)
- We will provide you (and any other interested stakeholder) with communication tools to use for "peer support" during the application phase (web-based)
- We will be your *contact point* for any other upcoming questions in the process
- We will ask you and others for *feedback* on the application process

#### What are the next steps?

- Our first WP 6 meeting is on June 27/28. Our work plan will be settled then.
- The supportive application criteria will be finalized soon after the WP 6 meeting
- From June 2013 March 2014 we are looking for interested organizations and projects to take part in the application of the QI/ QA tools
